GREEN TERRAZZO

Key Features of the Green Building Council's Ratings for Cement & Epoxy Terrazzo

Composition and Embodied Energy: Terrazzo is composed of naturally occurring materials.

Recycle/Reuse Content: Terrazzo can contain as much as 100% recycled content.

VOC Off-Gassing and Indoor Air Quality: Both cement based and thin set epoxy terrazzo systems are comprised of zero VOC materials.

Overall, on typical projects, terrazzo can realistically contribute to **five LEED credits**, or up to eight on a case-by-case scenario.
